	Gold	F	1	4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Squares
	Gold	G	4	2" x 12 1/2" Rectangles
	Red	H	2	4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Squares
	Green	I	4	2 5/8" x 2 5/8" Squares
	Blue	J	12	2 5/8" x 2 5/8" Squares
	Blue	K	4	2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Squares

If you need more details or left handed cutting instructions on using these tools please refer to your the general directions that came with your tools or visit Studio 180 design's website for videos.

For best results: Use a 1/4" seam allowance and press as indicated by arrows. Also, press your fabrics thoroughly using your favorite spray starch before starting your project.

Abbreviations

WOF= Width of the Fabric based on 42" selvage to selvage. HST = Half Square Triangle FG = Flying Geese

Half Square Triangles (HST)

Ruler: Tucker Trimmer® 1

1. **Draw** two diagonal lines 1/4" on either side of the center diagonal line on the wrong side of the (4) **Fabric D** square.
2. With right sides facing, **layer** a **Fabric K** square with a **Fabric D** square.
3. **Stitch** on the drawn lines, then **cut** down the middle.
4. **Press** seam in the direction indicated by arrows.
5. **Trim** to 2" using the **Tucker Trimmer® 1**.
6. Repeat the steps 1-5 above to make 8 **K/D HST Units**.
