- Tucker Trimmer® III (DT06)
- Large Square Squared® (DT14)
- Wing Clipper® I (DT07)

Additional Supplies

- Quilters Magic Wand (DT04)
- Straight edge ruler
- Mary Ellen's Best Press Spray® Starch
- Invisigrip (for back of tools)
- Fabric Pencil or Marker
- Rotary Cutter Blades

Primary Pattern Instructions

- Read all instructions before starting each month's project thoroughly.
- Pay close attention to the cutting instructions for each month. Over the months require you to cut and set aside fabric for the months ahead. Recommend that you label them and put them away in a save place.
- Use a ¼" seam allowance and press as indicated by the arrows.
- Before starting each month starch the fabrics well using Mary Ellen's Best Press Spray® Starch (*Recommended*)
- Be sure you start with a clean sewing machine and fresh needle.
- Start with a new rotary cutter blade.
- Save all scraps until the end, to assure you have enough fabric in case of mistakes.
- If you decide to use a specialty ruler, please remember to read your ruler instructions thoroughly before using them.

Queen Size Special Note

The Instructions for queen size quilts are found in the (Blue) parentheses throughout the instructions. To avoid any confusion when making your blocks you may want to highlight your project's requirements.
